



## JWFC - CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT

Players are the most important people in the sport. Playing for the team, and for the team to win, is the most fundamental part of the game. But not winning at all costs. Play and respect for all others in the game is fundamentally important.

### Obligations of paying match subs and fines

#### *A players Parent Should*

- Pay their child monthly membership fee of £20, by standing order or cash on the 14<sup>th</sup> of every month (Where applicable) - (We will grant each player a credit of one month's fees per season, if more than one month's fees go unpaid, it will result in your child being suspended from playing until all fees are paid up to date)
- Pay any fines within 14 days from the game in which their child was cautioned. (failure to pay will result in the fine being doubled and the child being unable to play until the outstanding fine amount has been paid in full)  
**Parents please note it is your responsibility to pay your child's fine.**  
£10 if they receive a Yellow Card, £35 if they receive a Red Card
- Respect the team managers - we kindly ask that you refrain from coaching from the side-line and allow our managers to coach the teams accordingly at both training and on match days.
- All Parents must remain behind the designated Respect line/barrier on match days.

### Obligations towards the game

#### *A player should*

- Give maximum effort and strive for the best possible performance during a game, even if his team is in a position where the desired result has already been achieved.
- Set a positive example for other players.
- Avoid all forms of gamesmanship and time-wasting.
- Always have regard for the best interests of the game
- Keep inappropriate language to minimum.

### Obligations towards one's own team

#### *A player should*

- Make every effort consistent with Fair Play and the Laws of the Game to help his own team win.
- Resist any influence, which might, or might be seen to, bring into question his commitment to the team winning.

### Respect for the Laws of the Game and competition rules

#### *A player should*

- Know and abide by the Laws, rules and spirit of the game, and the competition rules.
- Accept success and failure, victory and defeat, equally.

### Respect towards Opponents

#### *A player and parents should*

- Treat opponents with due respect at all times, irrespective of the result of the game.
- Safeguard the physical fitness of opponents, avoid violence and rough play, and help injured opponents.

### Respect towards the Match Officials

#### *A player and parents should*

- Accept the decision of the Match Official without any protest.
- Avoid words or actions, which may mislead a Match Official.
- Show due respect towards Match Officials.

### Respect towards Team Officials

#### *A player should*

- Abide by the instructions of their Manager, Coach and Team Officials, provided they do not contradict the spirit of this Code.
- Show due respect towards the Team Officials of the opposition.

### Obligations towards the Supporters

#### *A player should:*

- Show due respect to both his own and the opposition supporters.
- Should not react or become involved with the opposition supporters
